Have you ever felt like a sailor on a sinking ship? Some days I do and we don't have enough life jackets or life boats to save us all.

Money is like the life jackets and boats for gun rights litigation. Without funding for litigation we are drowning in a sea of anti-gunners and big governments.

As each of you are aware, the Madison Society Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit organization which only activity is to fight in the courts to save your rights. We have no paid staff, no offices, no lobbyist, and no attorneys on retainer.

Unlike others in this cause, the money raised goes to current and future litigation.

This week we are protecting a citizen of Oregon who visited his gravely ill sister in California from arrest and charges of having an AR15 with two high capacity magazines. These are illegal to own in California but perfectly legal in his home state. The freedom of travel, the right to self protection, and other Constitutional issues must be applied to this case. Note that we are currently involved in Nine (9) cases.
